## Frequently Asked Questions for Girl Scout Programs

---

### **COST**

#### **What are the costs of scout sessions?**

Private Session - Brownies \$250, Juniors \$450

Public Session - Brownies \$15 per girl, Juniors Day Session \$23 per girl

#### **What is the difference between a Private Session and a Public Session?**

The sessions are exactly the same in content and activities. Public sessions are events that the CLC has on schedule. A private session is scheduled on a day that is not on the CLC schedule. *Example:* A private session date may be set by a troop if they cannot attend any of the sessions that the CLC has on schedule. Private Sessions are only scheduled on the availability of the CLC schedule.

#### **What payment is required at registration? When is payment due?**

Registration is on a first come, first serve basis and payment is due in full at time of registration to hold your spot.

#### **What is the cancellation policy?**

A full refund will be given if the cancellation is received 15 days prior to the session date. After the 15 day point, the session fee is non-refundable. There is no refund for scouts that do not attend the program.

#### **What if any girls from the troop do not show up?**

There is no refund for scouts that do not attend the program.

#### **What if the troop brings extra girls on the day of the session?**

It is required that all girls pre-register before attending as sessions do fill to the maximum and close.

#### **Is there a fee for adults?**

There is no fee for adults attending day sessions.

### **RESERVATIONS**

#### **How many spots should be reserved if the actual number of participants is not known at this time?**

You may sign up and pay for the estimated number of girls that you think may attend. There is no refund for scouts that do not attend or do not fill the spots that were paid for.

#### **How do I know if I should sign up for a private session or a public session?**

The number of girls signing up determines the best choice. We are willing to do a private session for any number of girls up to 30. See table below:

Brownies > 16 - 30 girls	X

Juniors > 19 - 30 girls	X

### **How does a troop register for a session?**

It is best if registering as a troop, to collect all forms from your girls and mail them all in one envelope to us with your payment. Once we have processed your paperwork, you will receive a confirmation packet from us within 2 weeks.

## **WORKSHOP INFORMATION**

### **What are the lengths of the workshops?**

Brownies - Earth & Sky Try-It, Space Explorer Try-It (2 hours 15 minutes each)

Juniors - Space Traveler Badge (5 hours 30 minutes)

### **What do the girls do during the workshop**

### **How many adults should attend?**

We ask that you stick to the **Safety-Wise** Event Girl/Adult Ratio.

### **Can other aged Girl Scouts attend?**

No. Brownies should only attend Brownie sessions and Juniors should only attend Junior sessions.

### **Can siblings attend/participate?**

Siblings should be left at home. This is a badge-earning opportunity for the girl scouts.

### **Do the girls receive their badges at the workshop?**

Yes, badges are given out at the end of the session along with a Certificate of Completion. Badges are included in the cost of the session.

### **Do the girls receive a snack during the session?**

No, snacks are not provided. For Brownies doing both the Space Explorer and the Earth & Sky Try-It on the same day, they must bring a sack lunch from home. For Juniors doing the Space Traveler Session, they must bring a sack lunch from home. There is not enough time for any group to leave the center for lunch.
